Qualified Health Plans

When submitting a two page application to **ADD** a QHP, you must still list **ALL** the QHP's that the group currently has and note the plan that is being ADDED. This will help eliminate the confusion between "adding" a QHP and "changing" a QHP.

ESI Payment Schedule

How to receive payment:

- To receive an Insure Oklahoma/O-EPIC premium assistance payment, you must send the entire health plan invoice including the summary page (via mail- PO Box 18650, Oklahoma City, OK 73154-1650 or fax-405-530-3433) to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) each month.
- If the invoice is not received by OHCA, no Insure Oklahoma/O-EPIC premium assistance payment can be made.
- The OHCA must receive the employer's health plan invoice by the date listed as the "Last Day to Receive Invoices" date. (If the invoice is received after the due date, the Insure Oklahoma/O-EPIC premium payment will be delayed.)
- When the OHCA receives the invoice, they will proceed with payment processing. If the invoice is received by the "Invoice Due Date", payment will be issued on the "Payment Issue Date."
- Insure Oklahoma/O-EPIC premium assistance payments will be deposited into your bank account via Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT).
- You must always pay the total monthly health plan invoice to the health plan carrier. Subsidies are made in their prospective month, for example: If a January invoice is received in December, it will not pay until January.

Full time college students attending an accredited college may now be eligible for Insure Oklahoma health coverage. Full-time Oklahoma college students, ages 19 through 22, not employed or working at any size business (income guidelines remain the same as other adults at 200 percent FPL) may apply beginning March 1, 2009.
